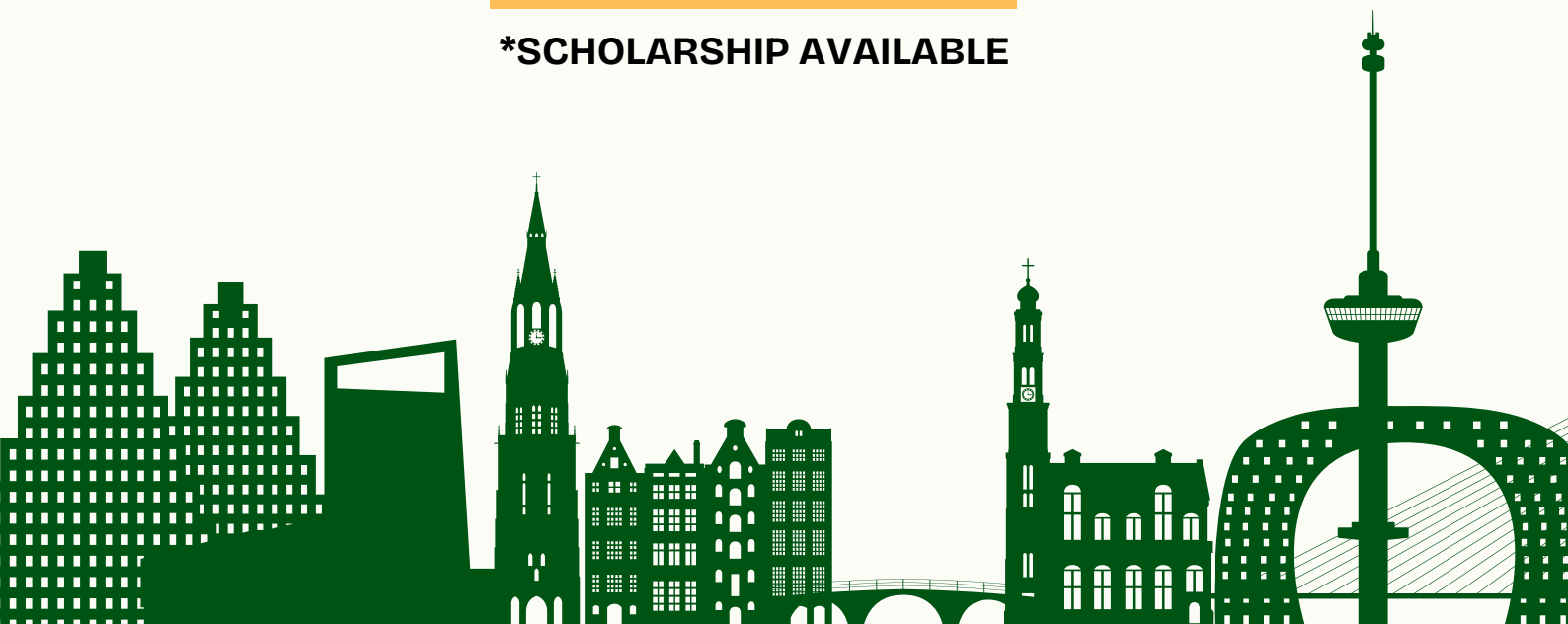

Step inside the **International Criminal Court (ICC)** and explore how international justice works beyond national borders. Learn how the Court investigates and prosecutes war crimes and crimes against humanity, turning legal principles into concrete mechanisms of accountability.

Visit the **International Court of Justice**, the principal judicial organ of the United Nations and discover how states settle disputes through international law. The ICJ represents the legal framework governing relations between nations and the peaceful resolution of conflicts.



Learn how the **Organisation for the Prohibition of Chemical Weapons**, responsible for implementing the Chemical Weapons Convention, coordinates international verification mechanisms and legal commitments to eliminate chemical weapons and enforce global disarmament norms.

DISCOVER THE DESTINATION



Discover how the **European Medicines Agency** regulates and supervises medicines across the European Union. The visit highlights the role of science-based regulation and institutional cooperation in safeguarding public health through shared legal and regulatory frameworks.

Engage with a unique ecosystem of NGOs, institutions, and innovators working on peace, justice, and human rights. **The Humanity Hub** showcases how collaboration and networks strengthen international cooperation and translate global values into collective action.

As part of the study trip, you will take part in an immersive workshop on negotiation **designed for future leaders in conflict resolution, governance, and global affairs.**

Led by experts in Conflict Resolution and Governance with extensive experience in mediation and dialogue facilitation, this workshop moves beyond traditional negotiation techniques.

Through the Dialogue Tables format, **you will engage in carefully facilitated conversations that prioritise courageous listening, critical reflection, and relational intelligence.** Rather than competing for solutions, you will learn to navigate complexity, hold tension, and lead meaningful conversations across difference.

This experience invites you to step into negotiation as a form of leadership: the ability to shape spaces, build trust, and engage constructively with conflict in professional arenas as well as in your own life.

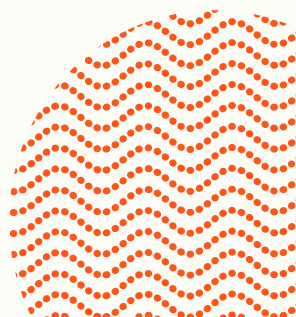
