Eastwest Model European Union



The EWEI Model UE is a project conducted by the Eastwest European Institute. A cycle of simulations divided into two phases for a full-immersion of the functioning mechanism of the European institutions. The perspective is to support the formation of a European leadership class of the future, through a transnational project of high technical level which at the same time make young people aware of an active and responsible European citizenship.

STEP 1: The simulation of the Committee on Civil Liberties, Justice and Home Affairs of the European Parliament will take place in five different cities and will be attended by 100 European university students chosen following a selection procedure conducted by the organizing committee.

Rome: 8-9 April 2019

Paris: 11-12 April 2019

Berlin: 15-16 April 2019

Istanbul: 6-7 May 2019

Warsaw: 13-14 May 2019

STEP 2: Gathered in Brussels on May 28th and 29th, the top 25 students of the national simulations + the first 29 students who signed up will participate in a simulation of the Council of the EU in the Justice and Home Affairs Configuration.

The other students will have the opportunity to simulate the European Parliament in plenary session, entering into the life of the ordinary legislative procedure, having the direct response of the Council that will decide on the same theme at the same time.

In the period prior to the experience, the participants will take part in a specific training course held online through the e-learning platform.

Main Topic



The participants to the EWEI-MEU will be called to work on the **issue of migration** and, more specifically, on the rethinking of the

How to participate



Selection interview

In order to take part in one (or more) of the simulations foreseen by the EWEI Model EU project, one must undertake an eligibility interview with our examiners. The **interview will take place in English via Skype** (if you don't have a personal account you must create one).

Students who display the greatest motivation to participate during the interview, along with an interest in European issues and in current affairs in general, will be approved for selection. They must also have an appropriate level of understanding and fluency in the English language.

How to apply

Interested students **must apply by filling in the online form** found on the following webpage (<http://ew-ei.eu/application>). To take part in the interview with one of the examiners, **candidates must set up their own appointment** through the dedicated software. Otherwise you may set up an interview by contacting the EWEI offices at +39 06 811 57 949.

In both cases, you must indicate your availability (by providing a date and a time) to engage in a Skype interview. If you haven't set up a personal Skype account yet, one must be created and its correct operation must also be verified.

Interview outcome

The **results** of the selection process shall be communicated by e-mail **within the following 24 hours**. If the outcome is positive, successful applicants may proceed to complete their enrolment by paying the participation fee for the project they have selected.
