What is it about?

The EWEI Intensive Training in EU Affairs is an encompassing, highly flexible programme which enables its participants to gain first-hand knowledge and understanding of EU politics.

It first offers an online Model EU supported by a training platform through which participants acquire an overall understanding of EU affairs through history, institutional affairs and a dedicated political focus for each course.

Secondly, participants can take part to an onsite simulation game held in Brussels or Strasbourg, where they can experience from within the challenges, constraints and opportunities EU officials experience in their daily work; a type of knowledge books cannot convey.

Lastly, EWEI organises a study visit to Brussels where participants can meet and discuss directly with top ranking EU officials to deepen and widen their understanding of the EU's internal dynamics and political challenges.

The project

Each participant will be able to pick and choose from the offer which course or series of courses he or she wishes to attend that fit his or her calendar and favourite learning approach. The project offers:

An online component. Get to know the EU from home through our Online Model EU (10-13 November 2020);

One or more onsite learning-by-doing exercise to pick from:

- The Model EU Strasbourg (25-27 January 2021),
- The World in Progress study mission to Brussels (15-18 March 2021),
- The Model EU Brussels (17-19 May 2021).

FROM NOVEMBER 10TH-13TH 2020


The Model EU Online Edition is a unique training experience. Without leaving your home, you can acquire new skills, better understand European politics and meet new people.


FROM JANUARY 25TH TO JANUARY 27TH 2021

On the days of 25, 26 and 27 of January 2021, simulations of the three major European institutions and the "Trilogue" will be held in the offices of the European Union in Strasbourg, with the aim of providing students with complete knowledge of the decision-making process of the European Union.

The "Trilogue" refers to a consultation between the Parliament, the Commission and the Council of the EU on legislative proposals, aimed at reaching a common final position.

MODEL EU Strasbourg

The MODEL EU Strasbourg takes part over three days of debates at the premises of the European Parliament. Participants to the Model EU Strasbourg will seek to reach an interinstitutional agreement on the three political priorities for the future of Europe.

The "Trilogue" refers to a consultation between the Parliament, the Commission and the Council of the EU on legislative proposals, aimed at reaching a common final position.

STUDY VISIT TO BRUSSELS

FROM MARCH 15TH TO MARCH 18TH 2021

On the days of 15, 16, 17 and 18 of March 2021,

The Study mission includes visits and high-level meetings at the core EU institutions, NATO Headquarters, the European Medicines Agency in Amsterdam and meetings with bilateral representatives and diplomats; and a one-day simulation exercise at the European Parliament.

Over their four-day stay at the heart of EU and international institutions in Brussels, participants meet and discuss with high-ranking officials, key players in dealing with the theme of the trip "a Geopolitical Union in Times of a Pandemic".





To ensure maximum flexibility, there are several levels of fees

*Paid-up participants to the Online Model EU will pay only the difference between the fee of the onsite project chosen and the amount they already paid, that is: 700€ for the WiP Study Mission to Brussels, and 145€ for the Model EU Strasbourg 2021 or the Model EU Brussels 2021.


Our Scientific Committee provides guidelines for the activities of the Eastwest European Institute, through bi-monthly meetings.

EWEI also produces and distributes the geopolitical magazine "eastwest", since 2004 (www.eastwest.eu).








