Terms & Conditions

1. Scope and general information

1.1. EWEI will provide the Student with the training course selected by the Student and the Student shall pay EWEI the relevant fees.

1.2. Once registered, the student must visit the www.ew-ei.eu website on a regular basis to review any information useful for the course he/she is registered for. The Student's registration is considered confirmed once the payment is received.

2. Payments and supporting letters of invitation

2.1. The total fee due to EWEI by the Student is indicated in the registration form and in the present document article 6. The registration is made on a rolling basis until the course is full. To secure a place on a course, the student must make the payment within 7 days after having submitted the registration form.

2.2. Acceptance or invitation letter can be provided upon the request to registrations@ew-ei.eu. Such a letter can be provided only upon the receipt of the payment.

2.3. The Student's registration will be confirmed once the payment is received by EWEI. The Student will receive electronic confirmation of his/her registration and will be assisted by one of the EWEI staff members. Any information request related to the course organization can be sent to model.eu@ew-ei.eu.

2.4. If the maximum course capacity is reached, EWEI reserves the right to refuse the registration prior to the payment being submitted by the candidate.

3. Cancellation, modification, and refund

3.1 Cancellation by EWEI

If the minimum number of participants requested for the course selected by the Student is not reached, EWEI reserves the right to cancel the course 1 (one) month before the first day of the start of

the webinars. In this case, the Student is entitled to receive a voucher with a total amount of the course fee valid for all EWEI courses for 18 (eighteen) months or a total refund of the application and course fee.

3.4 Cancellation by the Student

If the course is due to begin within 14 days from the date the registration form is submitted, then the participant cannot be reimbursed for any reason. The beginning of the course is meant to be the first day of the webinars.

The letter of withdrawal should be sent to registrations@ew-ei.eu having as the object "Withdrawal_Name of the Course_Student's Name Surname". The Student must be sure to receive the letter of response from EWEI staff proving that the withdrawal letter is received.

4. Voucher

Vouchers are valid for a period of 18 months and can be used for any EWEI short-term course.

5. Privacy

5.1 All webinar preparation courses will be recorded.

5.2 The student assigns to EWEI, without claiming anything, the right and consent to include his/her image and voice in communication and promotion;

5.3 At the end of the course, the student agrees to release a video (lasting 30 seconds) or written testimony of his/her experience.

6. Payment Process and Confirmation

All participants are requested to subscribe to the Eastwest online geopolitical magazine for a discounted fee of 5 (five) euros per year, to be paid on top of the course fee. The subscription can be cancelled at any time after the programme.

The fees shall be as follows:

- Application fee (non-refundable): €60,00
- Webinars fee: €96,00

- 22% VAT: €34,00

- Eastwest magazine annual subscription: €5,00

- Revenue stamp €2,00

Total (wire transfer): €197,00

In case of a PayPal payment, the Student should add the transfer fee of 4%

Total (PayPal payment): €204,88

The registration is made on a rolling basis until the course is full. To secure a place on a course, the candidate must make the payment within 7 days after having submitted the registration form and email the receipt to registrations@ew-ei.eu.

As stated, the registration is automatically considered official once the Student's payment proof is shared. No registration will be processed otherwise.

In case of technical issues with the payment transfer, the Student should promptly inform the EWEI staff.

7. Governing Law and Jurisdiction

This contract, together with the rights and obligations deriving from it, will be exclusively governed by and construed according to the laws of the Republic of Italy.

All disputes related to, caused by, or dependent upon, this contract, including those regarding the formation, validity, interpretation, execution, or termination of this contract, that are not resolved by amicable settlement, will be finally resolved by the Court of Rome.
